Credentials Check List for Tournament Teams

Your league president and/or representative should provide a copy of this check list to each tournament team manager along with the parental waiver/medical release form, the Coach Background Certification, proof of insurance, and birth certificates to bring to the Credentials Meeting.

League and Team Responsibilities

A representative from each tournament team must attend any scheduled Credentials meeting.

DBB TOURNAMENT TEAM ELIGIBILITY AFFIDAVIT (found on dbbusa.org)

A completed form signed by the league president. The league president will certify that the league and participants meet all requirements for tournament play. All information on the Tournament Affidavit must be provided from the information submitted on the league's regular season rosters. Players must be selected from the players listed on the league's regular season rosters. Player's names must be listed exactly like it is on the legal birth document. Full names, no initials, no nicknames, and no adopted names unless there is documentation of a legal name change.

BIRTH CERTIFICATES A copy of an acceptable birth record for each player.

DBB RELEASE OF LIABILITY (found on dbbusa.org)

A completed parental waiver/medical release form for each player. A copy of the individually signed forms should be placed in the team credential's booklet directly behind each birth record. Have the documents in the order they appear on the tournament affidavit.

LIABILITY AND ACCIDENTAL INSURANCE

A copy of league's Proof of Accident and Liability Insurance for the current season. Policy must be an Excess Accident policy with a Medical Limit of at least \$50,000 and a General Liability policy with an "each occurrence limit" of at least 1,000,000 combined single limits for "bodily injury" and "property damage". If the team does not purchase its General Liability Insurance from Sadler, it is required that its insurance certificate name DBB, Inc. as an "additional insured."

COACH BACKGROUND CHECK CERTIFICATION FORM (found on dbbusa.org)

A completed form signed by the league; with a copy to be retained by the league.

These documents should be put into a three-ring binder with the birth certificates and waivers inserted in the order the names are listed on the Tournament Team Affidavit. Binder should be presented to the Credentials Committee.

Lodging: All accommodations are at least 15 miles from the Sterlington complex. Plan travel up and down Hwy 165 accordingly. Team manager is responsible for having his team available a minimum of 45 minutes before scheduled game time.

PRE-GAME INFORMATION:

1. National Anthem and invocation at the beginning of each day.
2. Lineups are due in the Press Box 30 minutes before scheduled game times.
3. Due to the number of games being held, there will be no infield scheduled for the game field. Use any open fields for pre-game throwing. Batting cages are available at ULM Parks and at the Sterlington Complex.
4. Prior to the **first game** for each team, we will introduce both teams and have them line up along the first and third base lines. Have your team ready for the introductions as this will move quickly.
5. **There will be a mandatory Credential Check at 12:00 PM and Coach's Meeting 2:00 PM, Friday, July 17th. Junior Boys and Boys - Flex Room 1 at West Monroe Sports and Events, 875 Constitution Drive, West Monroe, Louisiana 71292. PARADE OF TEAMS AND OPENING CEREMONIES 2:30 PM - (WMSE)**

GAME INFORMATION:

1. Home and visitors will be pre-flipped and listed on the bracket. All teams should be ready to play at the conclusion of the proceeding game. We will attempt to start all games at their scheduled time.
2. Run Rules are found in the rulebook, Pg. 24, 4.10(d), (1), (2), and (3).
3. Pitching Rules are found in the Official Rules. Official scorers will provide total number of cumulative pitches that a pitcher has thrown. Scorers will have the official count. Immediately following each game, report to the scorer's booth to sign pitching affidavit. If not signed, we will not allow any changes to the affidavit. Please understand scorekeepers are busy with following games.
4. **(NO METAL CLEATS are allowed)** only turf shoes or plastic molded shoes.
5. Review the ULM University Parks and Sterlington Sports Complex Rules as they will be enforced as listed in the host packet.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Participating teams are requested to assist in the retrieval of baseballs that leave the playing field. Teams on their respective side of the playing field should assist in having baseballs returned to the designated area.
2. As we are on an extremely tight schedule, please remove all trash from the dugout upon completion of your game.
3. Cooler Policy: Covered in Host Packet: One team cooler for Florida Water is allowed. Any deviations from the park policy will have to come from the Tournament Host and not DBB, Inc.
4. DBB, Inc. reserves the right to amend the event bracket as it deems necessary. Teams will be notified if inclement weather causes a delay or change in a scheduled game time. Please be alert to possible changes.
5. **THE HOST WILL LIVE STREAM ALL TOURNAMENT GAMES AT THE STERLINGTON SITE.**

AWARDS:

1. DBB, Inc. will furnish a team award for the World Series Champions and Finalist. The World Series Champions will also receive a World Series Champions Pennant/Flag.
2. Top two teams will receive World Series awards as the tournament Champions and tournament Finalist.
3. A Sportsmanship award will be presented at the conclusion of the tournament.
4. Home-run balls to every player who hits a home-run during the Series.
5. A game ball presented to any pitcher who pitches a no-hitter of at least five innings during the Series.

ANNOUNCEMENT:

1. Rule 1:11 Page 35 defines player/coach uniform rule. DBB patches must be attached to the left arm sleeve. All players must be in full uniform to participate on the field. Coaches are allowed to wear matching short pants and must meet the following guidelines: **BUTTON UP, KNEE LENGTH, SHORTS MAY BE OF A COLOR MATCHING YOUR TEAM'S UNIFORM (Khaki, Black, Blue, White, Grey, etc) HOWEVER, ALL COACHES ON A GIVEN TEAM MUST MATCH. SHORTS STYLE SHOWN IN EXAMPLE BELOW.**

As we all know, the weather in North Louisiana is HOT and HUMID.
Players are at high risk for heat related illness during this time.

Some prevention tips:

Identify susceptible players; large individuals with large muscles
or fat layers or players who have a history of heat illness.

Acclimate players to the weather through planned workouts.
Start with short durations gradually increasing in length and intensity.

Generous free intake of fluids prior to - during - and after practice and games.
Fluid breaks should be every ½ hour during practice.

**Diet: FLUID REPLACEMENT IS MOST IMPORTANT
IN THE PREVENTION OF HEAT ILLNESS.**

Electrolyte replacement such as bananas for potassium,
potato chips for salt, fruits and vegetables should be included in the diet.

Louisiana Purchase Gardens and Zoo

This is an 80 plus acre zoological park and gardens for family fun and education with almost 2 miles of pathways wondering through animal exhibits, park like grounds and gardens. Don't miss the Zooasis Splash Pad, playground, Safari Boat ride, and Train ride.



Biedenharn Museum & Gardens

Discover Coca-Cola memorabilia and tour the historic home of Joseph Biedenharn, first Coca-Cola bottler, decorated by his daughter, opera singer Emy-Lou. Stroll through ELSong Gardens, and see rare Bibles and exhibits at the Bible Museum. End with a stop at the gift shop.



Chennault Aviation & Military Museum

The aviation portion highlights three historic chapters in the nation's and Monroe's history: the Navigation School; the birth of Delta Airlines; and Louisiana native General Claire Chennault. The military portion is portrayed through an abundance of weaponry, uniforms, photographs, documents and other artifacts depicting WWI through present day.

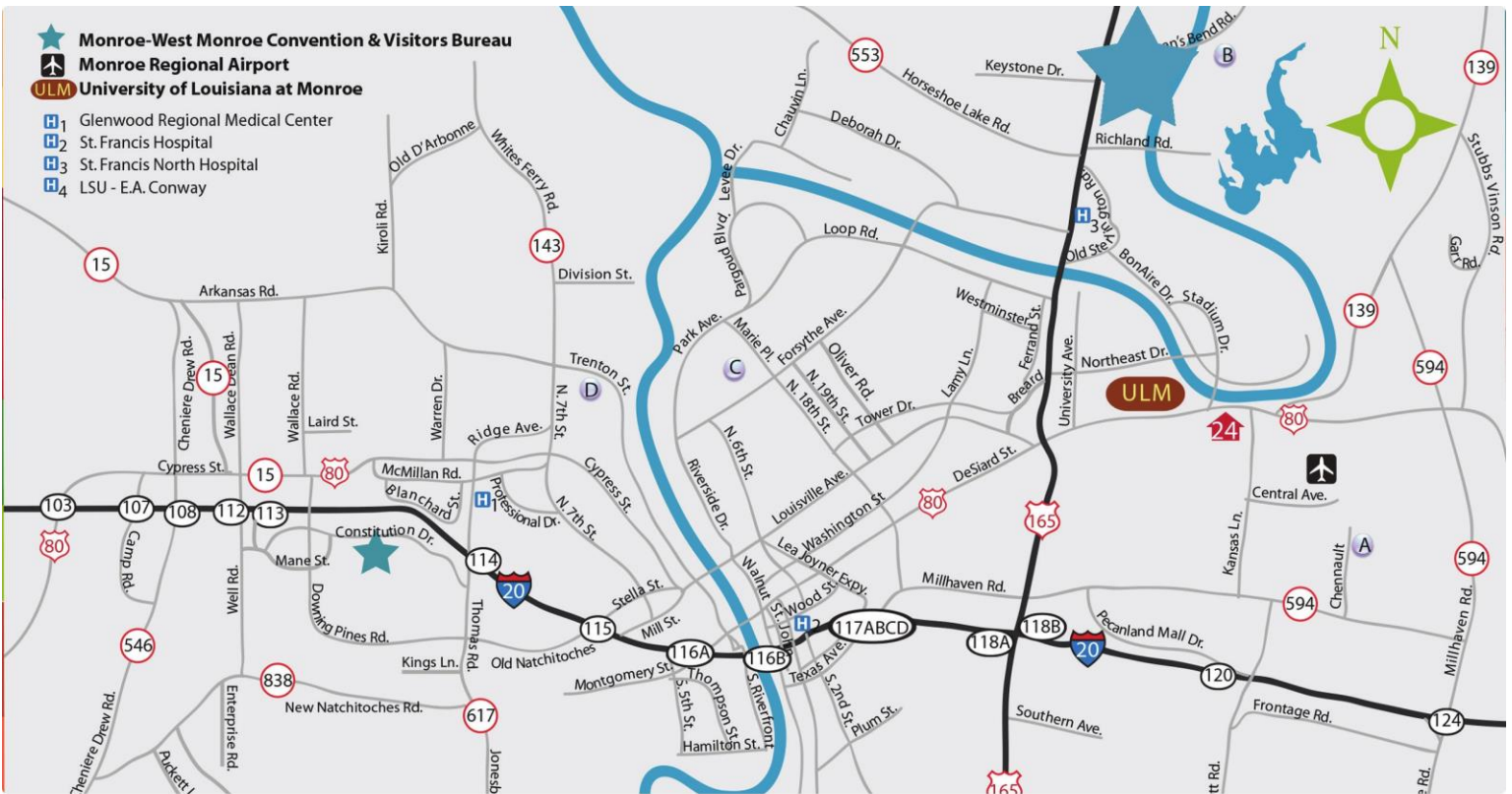


Catahoula's
